

MAINTENANCE GUIDE

How to take care of your natural stone

EASE YOUR MIND WITH THESE HELPFUL TIPS



DAILY CLEANING

Keeping the surface clean and tidy during use & cleaning spills as they occur is the best form of maintenance.

WIPE DOWN WITH A WET CLEANING CLOTH REGULARLY

Wet the cloth with clean water. Wipe the surface down. Once the surface is wet wipe away any marks or spills.



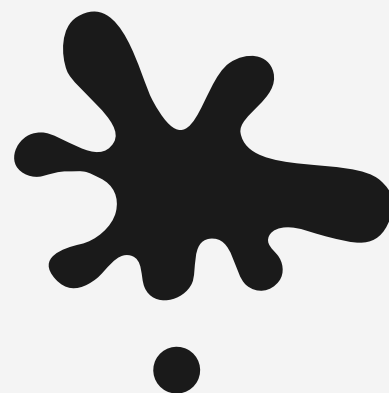
- *Sauces*
- *Carbonated Drinks*
- *Fruit Juices*

FOR DRIED ACIDIC SPILLS

Clean with water and a small amount of bicarb soda. Cleanse with water and dry.

FOR GREASE

Spot clean with diluted household detergent. (1 drop per 250ml of water). Cleanse with water and dry.



- *Wine*
- *Beetroot*
- *Tea/Coffee*
- *Glues*

FOR HARDER DRIED STAINS

Use a mixture of water & bleach at a ratio of 10:1. Cleanse with water and dry. (The bleach will not hurt the stone but be sure to cleanse with plenty of water afterwards)

DONT USE CHEMICALS REGULARLY

General surface cleaners build up a resin like substance when they dry on the surface which traps spills in the stone and makes it harder to clean over time.



DEEP CLEANING

Use Zexa K.N or Low Slip Floor Cleaner. 2 grams of this cleaner in 10L (a sink full) will remove all organic and some chemical residue from your stone. Wet & wipe, then dry to collect any lifted residue.

SANITISING

Food grade spray and sanitiser like Zexa Sani Clean are perfect for household use. Once you have wiped down your counter for the day, mist over a quaternary ammonium based sanitiser (don't wipe after) and you are done. Safe and ready to use again.



SEALING

Consult with us. If you aren't careful poorly sealed stone is harder to clean and maintain than any non-sealed surface.

SURFACE SELECTION

The easiest to maintain surfaces in order are:

- Polished
- Honed
- Brushed
